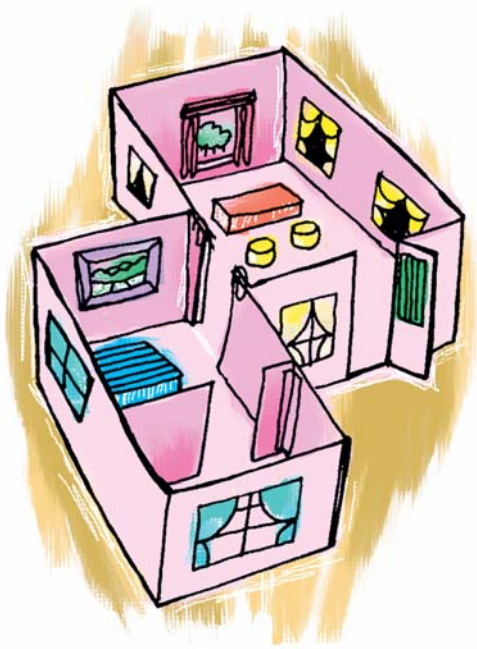
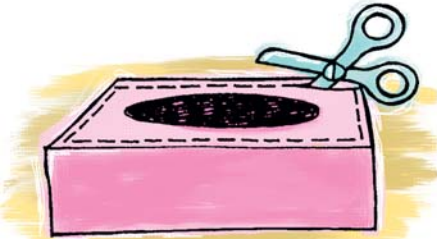


# Tissue-box dollhouse

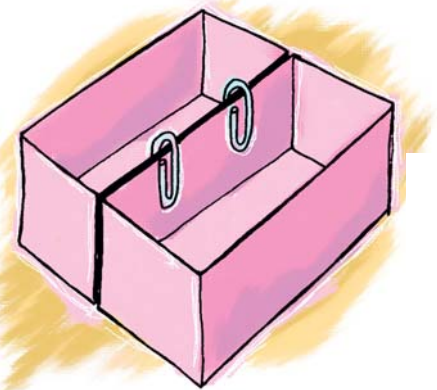
This dollhouse is made from empty tissue boxes. Begin with two rooms and add more when you have other empty boxes.



**1** Cut the tops off the boxes.



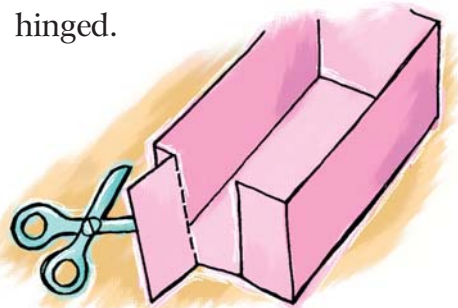
**2** Use the paper clips to fasten the boxes together side by side or end to end.



**3** Make doorways between the rooms by cutting out pieces of the boxes. (You will need to unfasten the boxes to cut along the bottom edges.)



**4** Create an outside door by making a cut down the side of one of the boxes. Also cut it across the bottom edge to the size you want. Fold back the door so it looks hinged.



## You will need

*2 or more empty tissue boxes*

*large paper clips*

*scissors*

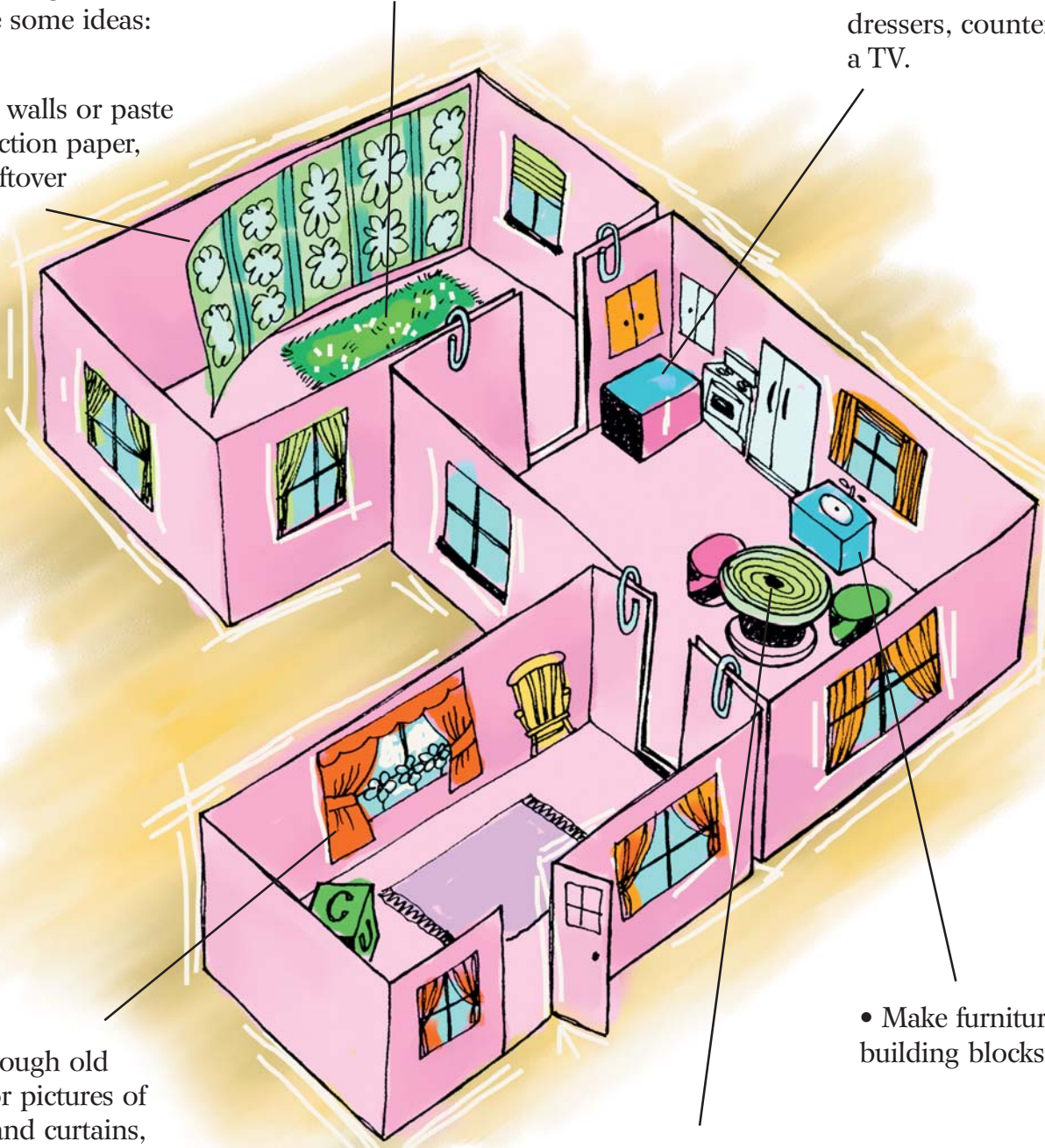
*catalog pictures, all-purpose craft glue and other craft supplies (see step 5)*

**5** Now comes the fun part — decorating the rooms! Here are some ideas:

- Paint the walls or paste on construction paper, fabric or leftover wallpaper.

- Use fun fur, felt, fleece or carpet scraps for floor coverings.

- Decorate wooden blocks to make dressers, counters or a TV.



- Look through old catalogs for pictures of windows and curtains, appliances, bathroom fixtures and other furnishings. Glue them to the walls.

- Make furniture from building blocks.

- Use an empty thread spool with a cardboard circle on top for a table. Use soft-drink bottle caps for chairs.
