
Lock-nest monster


Spot the monster and you'll know you're at the right locker.



Wrap a few layers of tape around the jaws of the pliers to cover the teeth or grooves. This protects the plastic coating on the hook.



Place the hook in the pliers as shown. Gently squeeze the pliers to bend the hook slightly closed.



You will need

- a 7/8 in. red hook
- a combination lock
- a small wooden bead
- a yellow screw anchor
- two tiny roly eyes
- electrical tape, locking pliers, scissors or utility knife, a ruler, strong glue or 5-minute epoxy, a toothpick, a damp rag

Slip an open combination lock through the hook to check that the hook won't fall off.

Remove the hook from the lock.
