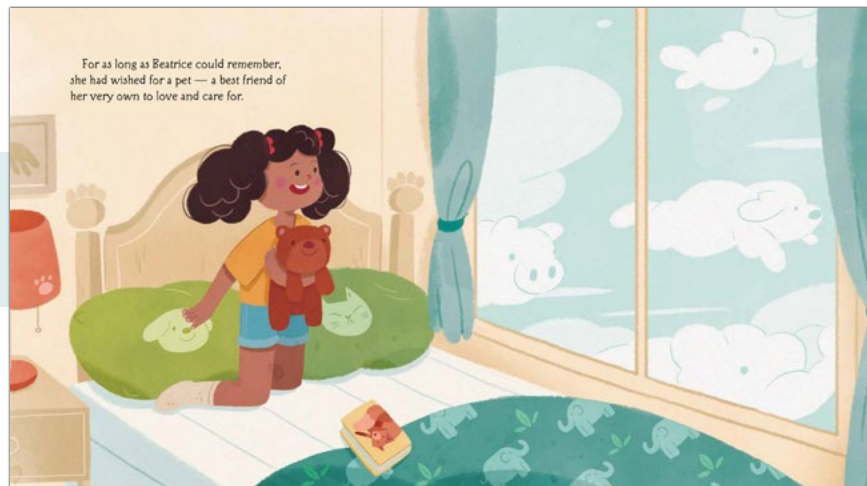

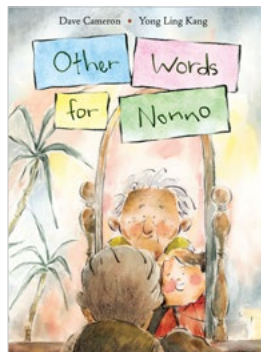

Benjamin's Thunderstorm

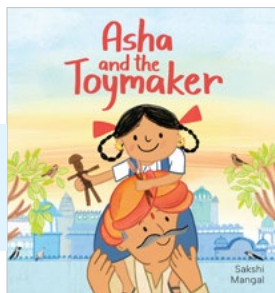

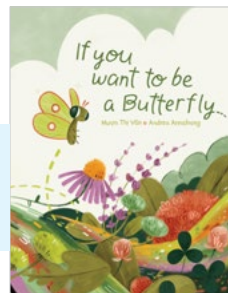
Asha and the Toymaker

If You Want to Be a Butterfly

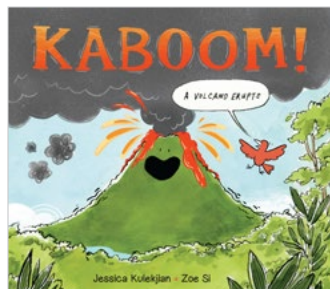

A modern hero: kids will be thrilled by her skill and inspired by her conviction.

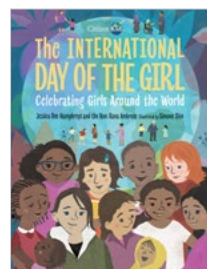

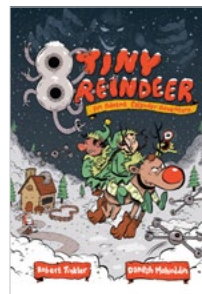




Rover and Speck: Splash Down!
