



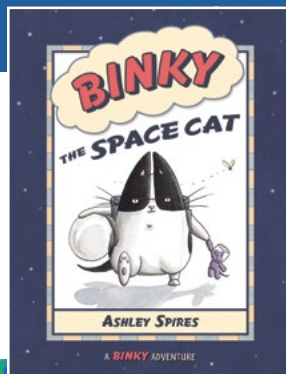

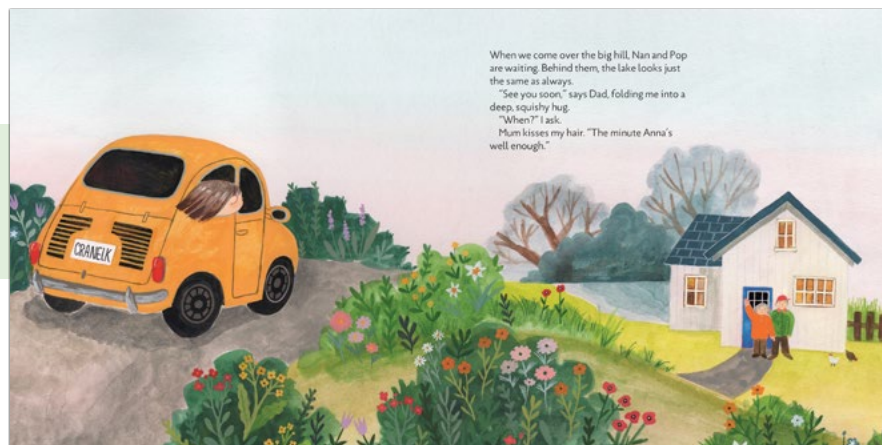
A Summer without Anna

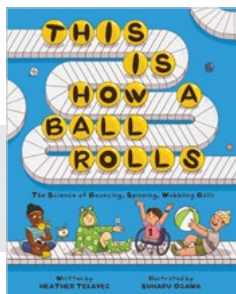

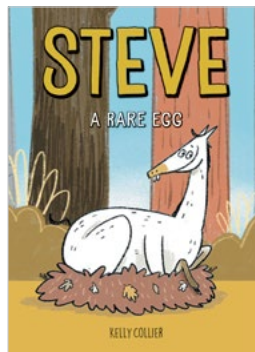
lightning. Until, at last, it's spent, "frizzled, drizzled, drained," leaving only a rainbow.
