

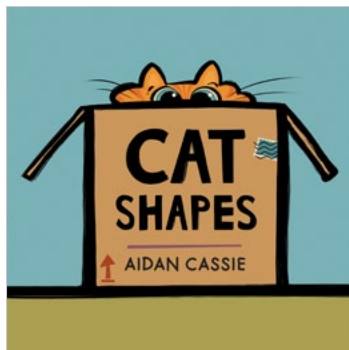

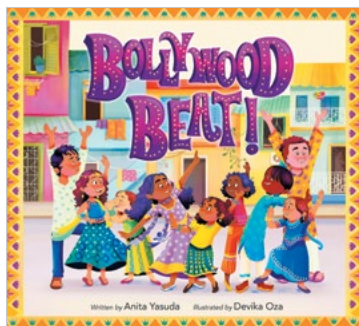
When We Go Home

Readers will be completely absorbed by this moving story about having, and making, a family.

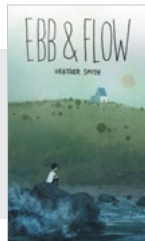
